



What you Need:

- Stencil
  - Ballpoint pen
  - (1) Fabric cut in 8" x 8" square
  - (1) 6" embroidery hoop
  - Scissors
  - Tape
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Prepping for Embroidery Class:

1. Cut your fabric piece to 8" x 8", this is the ideal size for a 6" hoop.
  2. Print your PDF stencil or use emailed stencil as a reference.
    - a. Tape printed stencil up to a window where natural light enters
    - b. If using stencil PDF as a reference to freehand, open and set up in a well lit area to draw.
      - i. If using stencil as a reference, make sure the image you draw stays within the 6" diameter of the hoop.
  3. Place your fabric on top of the stencil.
  4. Use a ballpoint pen to trace the stencil onto the fabric.
    - a. Whether you printed or freehanded the stencil, **DO NOT TRACE THE CIRCLE** this is a reference for you to see how it will fit once in your hoop.
    - b. Be weary of "inky" or "gel" pens that will bleed ink into your fabric.
  5. Once you have outlined your stencil on to the canvas you are done!
